This is a major fundraiser for our Club, and profits from the Derby are used to further protect and improve upon our truly World Class Salmon and Trout Fishery that we all enjoy so much in Lake Michigan! We are a 501(c)(3)non-profit organization recognized for tax deductible giving by the IRS. Our format this year we will be similar to 2023 with a few changes. We will be offering prizes for the top 10 largest fish caught by weight. Every 5th place after that from entries 15-200 will be assigned a prize and every 10th fish from entries 210-300 will also be assigned a prize at the end of the Derby according to weight. We hope to add more prize positions as more donations are received. A \$1000 prize will be awarded for the 100th place fish and a \$300 prize for the 500th place fish. A \$150 prize will also be awarded for each single largest fish by weight by species. The total prize value is expected to exceed \$10,000! **Only 1000 tickets will be sold**!! Our final prize list is not printed yet as prizes are still coming in. Big fish each day will also get a prize. Buy your Derby tickets and good luck to you!!! Become a member of GLSF-OZ at the Derby headquarters, at a reduced 2024 price from \$40.00 to \$25.00. If you fish for salmon and trout you should really belong to one of the many fine Clubs in Wisconsin that support the fishery!!

Information and Registration—2024 GLSF-OZ Fishing Derby

I. 2024 DERBY DATES

Begin	Friday, June 28	12:01 a.m.
Continues	Saturday, June 28	
Ends	Sunday, June 30	12:00 p.m.

II. SPECIES

Breakwall.

Five species of fish may be registered for the Derby: Chinook Salmon, Coho Salmon, Rainbow Trout, Lake Trout and Brown Trout.

III. BOUNDARY LIMITS

Derby boundary limits will be all Lake Michigan waters. NOTE: No fishing is allowed in WEPCO's "cooling pond" by South VII. DERBY PRIZES

IV. DERBY TICKETS

A. All advance sale Derby tickets are \$15.00 per individual ticket. B. Each individual can weigh one fish per ticket with 5 tickets maximum per day and 15 tickets maximum total for the Derby. Note: Each person must have their own ticket.

C. Tickets must be purchased prior to fishing, and any tickets sold after the Derby has started will be marked by a GLSF-OZ attendant as to the time and date of purchase. No tickets will be sold after 8:00 a.m. on June 28.

D. Tickets must be signed by the contestant in the area indicated at the time of purchase.

E. Each individual angler in a boat is requested to have a ticket.

- When fishing on paid charter boats, all fish entered must be 1. caught by the contestant without any assistance other than handing the rod to the angler and netting the fish.
- Charter Captains and members of their crew will not be eli-2. gible to register fish caught aboard a paid charter. Charter customers can register fish if eligible under Derby rules.

F. Tickets are available at the Port Marina Office (at the boat launch), from GLSF-OZ members, or by mail from Don Clark, 624 Deer Pass Road, Saukville, WI 53080.

V. FISH REGISTRATION

A. Fish registration hours are:

Friday & Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Sunday, June 30 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

B. All contestants in line at daily closing will be honored.

C. Entered fish must be caught on hook and line in accordance with the conservation laws of the State of Wisconsin.

D. Each contestant must hold a valid Wisconsin fishing license with salmon stamp (unless exempt from the law) and may be asked to present it at the fish registration area.

E. All fish caught by a contestant must be registered at Derby Headquarters within 24 hours and will be marked by a weigh-in attendant. Attendants will weigh only ONE fish per ticket.

F. No frozen or discolored fish will be accepted for registration. Judges will have the right to determine to validity of weight by cutting the fish. At the discretion of the judges, a lie detector (polygraph) test may be required of any contestant eligible for a prize.

VI. FISH DISPLAY

A. The top 5 fish will be placed on display during the Derby. Any fish out of a top spot will be removed from the display. Owner will be responsible for picking up fish before the end of the Derby. Unclaimed fish will be donated to charity.

A. Derby contest prizes will be awarded by individual fish weight. In case of a tie, the greatest length will place higher. If both weight and length tie, the earliest registration will place higher.

B. All prizes determined by standings at the close of the Derby. C. Prizes will be awarded for the top 10 places. If a contestant has a fish in one of the 10 places and registers a larger fish, the larger fish will take precedence over the smaller fish. D. Derby prizes will be awarded around 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, June 30. Winners not present at this time will be notified and must claim their prize at The Village Printer, Inc. 408 Dekora, Saukville, WI, phone 262-284-9898. Any prizes not claimed by July 30, 2024 are forfeited.

VIII. OTHER PRIZES

A. At the close of the Derby, after the top 10 finishers are awarded, a prize will be given for every 5th fish registered from entries 15-200 and every 10th fish registered from entries 210-300. Additional prize positions may be added at Club discretion. A \$1000 prize will be awarded for the 100th place fish and a \$300 prize for the 500th place fish .

B. A prize will be given for the largest fish caught each day.

C. A \$150 prize will be given for the largest fish of each species.

IX. LIABILITY EXCLUSION

Every reasonable precaution will be taken by the contest committee to protect property during the Derby. However, GLSF-Ozaukee Chapter. Its officers and members are not responsible for the safety or the property of participants from theft or damage or injury by fire, accident, vandalism or other causes. All participants further understand and agree to release and hold harmless the aforementioned from any liability or claim for damages incurred as a result of participation in the Derby in whatever form or manner said liabilities, damages or injuries might be incurred.

X. MISTAKES OR OMISSIONS

Mistakes or omissions are possible and are not meant to change rules.
